
The Earth is our planet. It has all the important things we need to live.

- It has a star called the Sun. The sun gives us light and Keeps us warm.





The Sun is the closest star to the Earth. It takes one year for the Earth to orbit the Sun.






The Earth is a sphere. It rotates on an invisible axis. The axis is a little bit tilted.



The side of the Earth that faces the sun is day. The side that faces away from the sun is night.

It takes one day and one night for the Earth to spin completely around. The top part of the Earth is called North.




The bottom part of the Earth is called <u>South</u>.



As the Earth <u>orbits</u> the sun, something amazing happens! The tilt of the axis makes the seasons.





As the Earth travels around the sun, the seasons change.




The seasons depend on where the Earth is on its path around the sun.
